One of the key characteristics of First Baptist Church Statesboro is the multigenerational mix within our congregation. Blending and weaving five generations into one congregation is not easy, but we've chosen this pathway because we feel it is healthy, biblical, and most impactful.



Our worship services today highlight the multigenerational commitment of our congregation as you see multiple age groups leading in worship and serving.

Being a multigenerational church requires intentionality—stated more simply, it won't happen by accident. The human heart naturally gravitates to familiar people and places, yet other generations are unlike our own, requiring intentional effort to mix and integrate them. Holy Land – June 2024

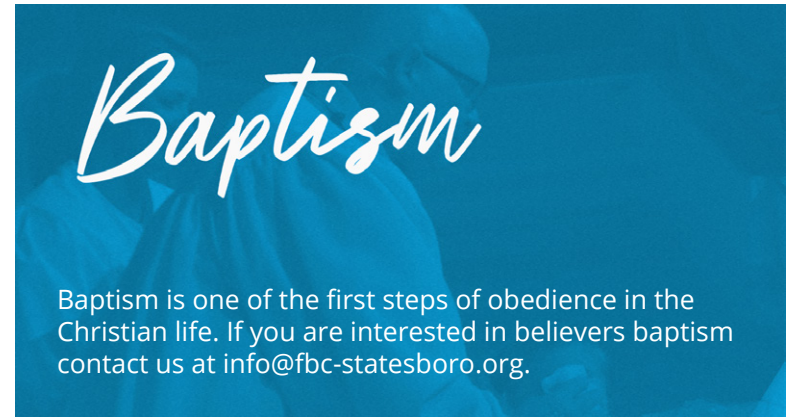
